## BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES OF APRIL 15, 1980

The Board of County Commission met this day in regular session with the following members present, to-wit: Lloyd Tatum, Chairman, Clayton Shiver, Gene Bailey, Bobby Varnum and Donnell Whitfield.

Willie D. Wise, Clerk, Sheriff William G. Smith and Attorney Bill Corbin were present and acting. The meeting was called to order by the Sheriff followed with prayer by Commissioner Varnum.

Mr. Gene Carter, Secondary Road Superintendent, made a report to the Board of the expenditures to run the Secondary Road Department and of the \$1,400.00 allowed for the month.

Mr. James Roy Willis met with the Board regarding a fence row which was pushed on his property without his permission. Commissioner Whitfield stated that a claim had been filed with the county's insurance carrier and the Board was waiting on their decision.

Commissioner Shiver stated that he had a complaint about a person from Liberty County working at the Calhoun County Library in Blountstown. Commissioner Varnum stated that he would check into this and report back to the Board.

Mr. Ellis Melvin, County Road Superintendent, made a report to the Board on the County Road Department.

Mr. Don Johnson with the Apalachee Regional Planning Council stated that a survey was being made by the Council on the energy crisis at the courthouse and would make a report at the next meeting.


