BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES OF SPECIAL SESSION JANUARY 20, 1983

A motion was made by Commissioner Peacock, seconded by Commissioner Whitfield and duly carried to hire Mike Tucker to establish a General Fixed Assets Ledger.

Commissioner Whitfield asked the Clerk if the minutes of the January 18, 1983, meeting were ready to be approved. The Clerk stated that since the meeting was taped 2 days prior that they would not be ready until February 1.
