BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES OF MAY 10, 1983

The Board of County Commission met this day in special session with the following members present,to-wit: Jack Bowman, Chairman, Drew Peacock, Monore Cox and Donnell Whitfield. Commissioner Roy Bailey was absent due to a death in his family.

Clerk Willie D. Wise was present and acting.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bowman.

Commissioner Bowman stated the meeting was called for the purpose of a budget review.

Clerk Willie D. Wise presented the Board members an investment statement with a balance of \$864,421.33 as of 5-10-83.

Commissioner Peacock stated that Frank Guilford, Bowers Sandusky, and Terry Myles were appointees of Calhoun County to serve on the J.T.P.A.

Mr. Robert Nations, Florida Engineering, met with the Board to discuss the roads to be paved pertaining to the bids received and tabled on May 3, 1983.

A Motion was made by Commissioner Whitfield, seconded by Commissioner Peacock and duly carried to rescind his prior Motion on 5-3-83 to table re-surfacing bids, due to his consulting with the County Engineer.

A Motion was made by Commissioner Peacock, seconded by Commissioner Whitfield and duly carried to accept the low bid of Baxter Asphalt Company of 20' leveling course at \$3.23 per foot and 18' at \$2.91 per L.Foot and 5¢ per L. foot traffic stripping. (See attached letter from Baxter Asphalt, Louie W. Seay, Jr.

The Board agreed that the following roads will be re-surfaced if money is available. Highway 69 A North of 274 to County Line, Hwy 286 or Ocheessee Road, Charlie Johns St., from 71 to 69; Parts of hwy 392 where needed, Hugh Creek Road from 71 S to Woods Cemetary. When money becomes available, 69 A South of 274 East will be resurfaced. Commissioner Bowman recommended to the Board to re-surface Mt. Olive Road first.

A Motion was made by Commissioner Whitfield, seconded by Commissioner Peacock and duly carried to resurface Mt. Olive Road first and after completion, the Board will decide on remaining roads.

A Motion was made by Commissioner Peacock, seconded by Commissioner Cox and duly carried to adjourn.

There being no further business, the Board did then adjourn.
