BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSION MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING SEPTEMBER 20, 1984

The Board of County Commission met this date in special session for the purpose of a public hearing on the proposed budget for the Fiscal Year 1984-85 with the following members present, to-wit: Drew Peacock, Chairman, Roy Bailey, Donnell Whitfield, Monroe Cox and Jack Bowman.

Clerk Willie D. Wise was present and acting.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Peacock and followed with prayer by Commissioner Whitfield.

Chairman Peacock recommended that the proposed millage rate be cut from 10 mills to 8 mills, and that the millage rate for General be set at 7 mills and Fine and Forfeiture millage rate be set at 1.

After much discussion on millage and budget cuts, a motion was made by Commissioner Whitfield, seconded by Commissioner Bowman and duly carried to cut the proposed millage rate for the Fiscal Year 1984-85 from 10 mills to 8 mills with General Fund millage rate to be 7 mills and Fine and Forfeiture millage rate to be 1 mill.

A motion was made by Commissioner Whitfield to delete the line item for Capital Improvements for \$60,000.00. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bailey and duly carried.

There being no further business, the Board did then adjourn.
