BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES OF MEETING SEPTEMBER 29, 1986

The Board of County Commissioners met this date in special session for the purpose of budget review of the F iscal Year 1986-87 budget, due to discontinance of Federal Revenue Sharing, with the following members present, to wit: Chairman Charles Richards, Commissioners Emmanuel Hires, Ronald Wood, and Drew Peacock.

Clerk Wise, Deputy Clerk Gail O'Bryan and Sheriff Smith were present and acting.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Richards.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hires, seconded by Commissioner Peacock, and duly carried to amend line item-01-510-130-06936/513.9306 by 828.00 for Fiscal Year 1985-86.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wood, seconded by Commissioner Peacock, and duly carried to amend the Clerk's Budget by 1043.67 for Fiscal Year 1985-86.

Clerk Wise presented a voucher to the board for comp time hours for Fernwood Bailey. The board decided to table the comp time issue on Fernwood Bailey until further research could be done such as the research employee regulations a nd time sheets pertaining to same.

The board and Clerk Wise discussed, at length, the loss of federal revenue sharing funds which was a loss of revenue to Calhoun County of \$125,000.00.

The board discussed the sanitary landfill and cost of same, and the possibility of a users fee or service charge for dumping garbage.

The board agreed to Attorney House research obtaining possible revenues for Fiscal Year 1986-87 by way of a s ervice charge for services.
