ATTORNEY HOUSE'S REPORT ON SANTA FE

ATTORNEY HOUSE STATED HE HAD SPOKEN WITH BOB HADSEN, VICE PRESIDENT OF SANTA FE HOSPITAL AND SANTA FE HAD AGREED TO LEAVE THE WORKING CAPITOL THAT WAS THERE WHEN THEY TOK OVER THE LEASE OF THE HOSPITAL. FURTHER, HE STATED THEY HAD AGREED TO LEAVE ALL COMMODITIES, SUCH PHARMACUTICAL SUPPLIES, ETC. HOSPITAL.

UNITED HOSPITALS PROPOSAL TO LEASE HOSPITAL

HOUSE READ A LETTER HE HAD RECEIVED FROM UNITED HOSPITALS, MEMPHIS, TENN., STATING THEIR PROPOSAL FOR LEASING CALHOUN GENERAL.

HEALTH CARE MANAGEMENT PROPOSED CONTRACT

HE STATED A PROPOSAL CONTRACT HAD RECEIVED FROM HEALTH CARE MANAGEMENT GROUP, BIRMINGHAM, AL. HOUSE ALSO SAID HE, IN TURN, HAD PREPARED A COUNTER PROPOSED CONTRACT AND WAS MEETING WITH HEALTH CARE MANAGEMENT GROUP TOMORROW TO DISCUSS THE CONTRACTS.

FUNDING FOR HOSPITAL DISCUSSED

THE BOARD AND THE AUDIENCE DISCUSSED REPAIRS, BLUE CROSS/BLUE SHIELD. MEDICARE, INDIGENT CARE, AND THE POSSIBILITY OF A SALES TAX, AS A MEANS OF FUNDING FOR THE HOSPITAL.
