COMMISSIONER WOOD STATEMENT INRE OF RACE TRACK ON HWY 274 MR. ROGER NICHOLS, SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO REQUEST THE BOARD TO UPDATE THE EXISTING RESOLUTION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$5,000,000.00 BOND ISSUE FOR SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY DEPUTY TATUM AND FOLLOWED WITH PRAYER BY COMMISSIONER DILLARD AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER RICHARDS, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND DULY CARRIED TO RENEW THE EXISTING RESOLUTION TO SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD FOR \$5,000,000.00 BOND ISSUE.

MR. GEORGE BRAESE, MOSSY POND FIRE DEPARTMENT WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO DISCUSS EQUIPMENT NEEDED FOR THE MOSSY POND FIRE DEPARTMENT. HE STATED HE NEEDED A SIREN AND NOZZLE FOR THE FIRE TRUCK.

THE BOARD APPROVED THE PURCHASE OF THE NOZZLE FOR THE MOSSY POND FIRE DEPARTMENT.

COMMISSIONER WOOD RELATED TO THE BOARD THAT A RACE TRACK HAD BEEN ESTABLISHED ON HIGHWAY 274 W AND THAT A NUMBER OF PEOPLE HAD EXPRESSED TO HIM A CONCERN FOR THE SAFETY OF THE SPECTATORS. COMMISSIONER WOOD FURTHER STATED HE HAD ATTENDED A RACE THERE AND DID SHARE THAT CONCERN. HE THEN PROPOSED TO THE BOARD THAT SOME REGULATORY PROCEDURE BE ESTABLISHED THAT WOULD ENABLE THE COUNTY TO HAVE SOME INVOLVEMENT IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW BUSINESS AND INSURE THAT CERTAIN GUIDELINES ARE COMPLIED WITH BEFORE A NEW BUSINESS BECOMES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, IN ORDER TO HELP ENSURE THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND WELFARE OF CALHOUN COUNTY CITIZENS AND VISITORS TO OUR COUNTY.

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COMMISSIONER WOOD REPORTED HE HAD RECEIVED A CALL FROM GRANT GENTRY CITY MANAGER, REQUESTING RUNNING UTILITIES DOWN THE COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY TO THE PRISON SITE AND ALSO PERMISSION TO RUN SEWER LINES. HE STATED MR. GENTRY HAD REQUESTED PERMISSION TO CUT THE ROAD OR BORE UNDER THE ROAD. COMMISSIONER WOOD STATED HE HAD TOLD MR. GENTRY HE FORESAW NO PROBLEM WITH RUNNING THE UTILITIES ALONE COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY BUT WOULD BRING THE SEWER LINE ISSUE BEFORE THE BOARD.

AFTER DISCUSSION THE BOARD AGREED FOR COMMISSIONER GRANT TO MEET WITH THE CITY COUNCIL AND FOR ATTORNEY HOUSE TO DRAW UP A CONTRACT BETWEEN CITY AND COUNTY RE: RESPONSIBILITY OF REPAIRING THE ROAD AFTER SEWER LINE IS LAID.

MR. BILLY ROBERTSON, DIVISION OF FORESTRY PRESENTED THE BOARD WITH THE ANNUAL REPORT ON CALHOUN-LIBERTY FORESTRY DEPT. FROM JULY 1, 1986-JUNE 30, 1987.

MR. ROBERTSON REPORTED THAT THE DIVISION OF FORESTRY WILL TRY AND GET ANOTHER HOSE FOR THE MOSSEY POND FIRE DEPT.

THE BOARD DISCUSSED AND APPROVED A LETTER TO THE APALACHEE REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL STATING CALHOUN COUNTIES OVER ALL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND CONCURRENCE WITH THE DISTRICT PLAN.

COMMISSIONER WOOD PRESENTED CORRESPONDENCE FROM BASKERVILLE-DONAVAN ENGINEERS RE: COST ESTIMATION OF \$5,000.00 THRU 10-15-87 ON AGRI-PARK GRANT APPLICATION.

THE BOARD TABLED THE BASKERVILLE-DONOVAN FEE UNTIL THE NEXT BOARD MEETING WHEN LARRY MCGLOTHIN COULD BE PRESENT FOR QUESTIONS.

COMMISSIONER WOOD PRESENTED SIX COMPLAINTS FILED BY ROAD DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES AGAINST ROAD SUPERINTENDANT FERNWOOD BAILEY.

THE BOARD TABLED THE COMPLAINTS UNTIL FURTHER STUDY BY THE BOARD.

COMMISSIONER WOOD PRESENTED A LETTER FROM BOB KING, BAY ENGINEERING, EXTENDING HIS PERSONAL PRAISE OF THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT ON THEIR SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A DIFFICULT ROAD PROJECT (OGLESBY ROAD) WITH LIMITED ROAD

CITY'S REQUEST TO USE COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY FOR UTILITIES TO PRISON

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SET A SPECIAL BOARD MEETING FOR THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 1987 AT 6:00 P.M. ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1987-1988.

THE BOARD DISCUSSED REPAIRS NEEDED TO DISTRICT 5 MOTOR GRADER AND AFTER DISCUSSION, A MOTION BY COMMISSIONER DILLARD, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER GRANT AND DULY CARRIED TO APPROVE THE REPAIRS TO THE DISTRICT 5 MOTOR GRADER IN EXCESS OF \$2,500.00.

THE BOARD AGREED BY CONSENUS FOR THE ROAD CREW TO ROTATE EVERY TWO WEEKS IN EACH DISTRICT AND FOR COMMISSIONER GRANT TO COORDINATE SAME WITH THE ROAD SUPERINTENDANT.

A MOTION BY COMMISSIONER RICHARDS, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND DULY CARRIED TO APPROVE LICENSE TO CARRY FIREARMS FOR RONALD WOOD.

COMMISSIONER DILLARD RECOMMENDED TO KEEP WEATHERIZATION SUPERVISOR ON FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER DUE TO HIS CONFERRING WITH RAY SMITH, DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM, AND WAS TOLD THE GRANT SHOULD BE APPROVED WITHIN TWO OR SO WEEKS.

THE BOARD BY CONSENSUS AGREED TO KEEP WEATHERIZATION SUPERVISOR FAYE BAILEY ON FOR 2 WEEKS AT \$5.00 PER HOUR AND UPON RECEIPT OF THE WEATHERIZATION GRANT HER SALARY WOULD RETURN TO \$7.49 PER HOUR.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER HIRES, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER RICHARDS, AND DULY CARRIED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF AUGUST 18, 1987 AS READ.
