CALL TO ORDER

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY COMMISSIONER WOOD AND FOLLOWED WITH PRAYER BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG.

BASKERVILLE-DONOVAN FEE DISCUSSED INRE 5,000.00 REQUEST FOR WORK ON AGRI-PARK GRANT LARRY MCGLOTHLIN, BASKERVILLE-DONOVAN ENGINEERS WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO DISCUSS PROPOSED AGRI-PARK GRANT AND FINANCIAL ASPECTS OF THAT GRANT. MR. MCGLOTHLIN REPORTED ON THE STEPS TAKEN AND WORK PREFORMED BY HIS COMPANY RELATING TO THE WRITING OF THE GRANT APPLICATION. HE STATED THE \$5,000.00 COMPENSATION HIS FIRM HAS ASKED FOR WAS ADDITIONAL WORK DONE BY HIS COMPANY IN ADDITION TO WORK BEING DONE ON EDA GRANT.

MR. MCGLOTHLIN TO MEET WITH BOARD ON THIRD TUESDAY OF OCT. AT 5:30 TO DISCUSS FINANCIAL ASPECTS THE BOARD POSED MANY QUESTIONS TO MR. MCGLOTHLIN RE: ADDITIONAL COST AND SERVICES REGARDING THE EDA GRANT AND AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION, THE BOARD AND MR. MCGLOTHLIN AGREED TO MEET ON THE THIRD TUESDAY OF OCTOBER AT 5:30 P.M. TO ADDRESS THE FINANCIAL ASPECTS OF THE EDA GRANT FURTHER.

JUAN LIMA WAS PRESENT TO DISCUSS SOLID WASTE PROBLEMS AND SUB-DIVISION GUIDELINES JUAN LIMA, REPRESENTING THE CHIPOLA RIVER PROTECTIVE BASIN ASSOCIATION, WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO DISCUSS SOLID WASTE PROBLEMS. MR. LIMA POINTED OUT SOME PITFALLS OF MASS INCENERATORS. HE STATED THAT AT CERTAIN TIMES OF THE YEAR BECAUSE OF PREVAILING BREEZES, CALHOUN COUNTY IS GETTING POLLUTION FROM BAY COUNTY'S INCENERATOR. MR. LIMA ALSO DISCUSSED SUB-DIVISION GUIDE LINES AND ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO SAME. HE STATED HIS GROUP[FELT THERE SHOULD BE MORE COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE AGENCIES INVOLVED WITH REGULATION OF SUB-DIVISIONS.

WILLIDEAN BOZEMAN, N.W. DRUG COUNCIL, WAS

PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO REQUEST THAT THE DRUG COUNCIL BE MOVED FROM THE 2ND FLOOR TO THE 3RD FLOOD DUE TO THE NOISE FACTOR ON THE 2ND FLOOR.

A MOTION BY COMMISSIONER HIRES, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER DILLARD AND DULY CARRIED TO ALLOW THE N.W. DRUG COUNCIL TO MOVE FROM THE 2ND FLOOR TO THE 3RD FLOOR.

LEE ROBERTSON, CHAIRMAN CALHOUN COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION, MET WITH THE BOARD TO REQUEST A PERMANENT MEETING PLACE FOR THE PLANNING COMMISSION SO THAT THEY MIGHT ADVERTISE THEIR MEETINGS AND HE ALSO WANTED TO REPORT THAT SOME MEMBERS ARE NOT ATTENDING MEETINGS DUE TO THE ABOVE REASONS. HE STATED THE COMMISSION NEEDS A PLACE TO STORE THEIR SUBDIVISION MATERIALS AND PLANS. HE ALSO REQUESTED THAT THE CONSULTING FIRM OF CLARK, ROUMELIS AND ASSOC., BEGIN MEETING WITH THE COMMISSION ON THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

COMMISSIONER WOOD STATED THE BOARDS APPRECIATION FOR THE FAITHFULLNESS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS.

AFTER DISCUSSION, THE BOARD AGREED TO ALLOW THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO MEET AND STORE THEIR MATERIALS IN THE OLD HUD OFFICE ON THE 2ND FLOOR IF IT MEETS WITH THE PLANNING COMMISSIONS APPROVAL.

COMMISSION WOOD ALSO ADVISED HE WOULD CONTACT THE FIRM OF CLARK, ROUMELIS AND ASSOCIATION AND ASK THEM TO ATTEND THE MEETINGS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION.

ATTORNEY HOUSE STATED HE HAD FILED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE. COMMISSIONER WOOD STATED HE WOULD CHECK WITH THE CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR RE: CERTIFICATION OF THAT FIRE DEPARTMENT. MR. BRAESE ALSO REQUESTED NEEDED EQUIPMENT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,969.00.

COMMISSIONER DILLARD STATED IF FUNDS WERE AVAILABLE FOR THE EQUIPMENT HE WOULD RECOMMEND THAT THE EQUIPMENT BE BID DUE TO AMOUNT OF MONEY REQUESTED.

MR. SLOAN'S OFFER WAS REJECTED BY BOARD THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REJECTED THE OFFER AND INSTRUCTED ATTORNEY HOUSE TO NOTIFY MR. SLOAN OF THIS ACTION.

ATORNEY HOUSE RECOMMENDED SENTING LETTER TO FERWOOD BAILEY INRE COMPLAINTS FILED ATTORNEY HOUSE RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD WRITE A LETTER TO ROAD SUPERINTENDANT ALONG WITH COPIES OF THE COMPLAINTS FILED AGAINST HIM, NOTIFYING HIM OF A DATE AND TIME OF A HEARING IN ORDER TO ADDRESS THE COMPLAINTS.

COMMISSIONER DILLARD STATED HE WANTED THE HEARING TO BE HELD DURING THE DAY ON COUNTY TIME. COMMISSIONER DILLARD STATED ONLY TWO OF THE MEN FILING COMPLAINTS WORKED UNDER THE ROAD SUPERINDENT AND HE WANTED THE WHOLE ROAD DEPARTMENT PRESENT NOT JUST THE MEN THAT FILED COMPLAINTS, AND HE ALSO WANTED THE HEARING TO BE HELD DURING THE DAY ON COUNTY TIME.

COMMISSIONER DILLARD REPORTED THAT THE COUNTY MECHANIC'S HAD SPENT 93,000.00 COMMISSIONER DILLARD REPORTED THAT THE COUNTY MECHANIC'S BUDGET WAS FOR \$50,000.00 AND OF THIS DATE HE HAD SPENT APPROXIMATELY \$93,000.00.

COMMISSIONER WOOD INSTRUCTS MRS. BAILEY TO COME BACK TO WORK TOMORROW

BOARD RECESSES

LOGAN BARBEE MADE A REPORT ON THE AQUA PARK.

CLERK WISE REPORTED IT WAS BROUGHT TO HIS ATTENTION THAT THE LIBERTY JOURNAL HAD REPORTED THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HAD ENTICED THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO MOVE TO OFFICE SPACE AVAILABLE IN THE CALHOUN COUNTY COURTHOUSE. CLERK WISE STATED MARY CLEMMONS HAD CONTACTED HIM REGARDING SPACE AND HE HAD REPORTED SAME TO THE BOARD. THE BOARD DID NOT IN ANYWAY SOLICIT THE DEPT. OF LABOR.

COMMISSIONER DILLARD REPORTED THAT HE HAD SPOKEN WITH JANEY NUDIE, D.C.A., WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM AND HAD BEEN INFORMED THAT THE UPCOMING GRANT HAD BEEN APPROVED BY THE GOVERNOR'S ENERGY OFFICE AND THE GRANT SHOULD BE UP-COMING WITHIN TWO WEEKS AND WOULD RECOMMEND THAT MRS. BAILEY BE KEPT ON IN LIEU OF PAYING UNEMPLOYMENT SINCE MRS. BAILEY DOES APPROX. 75% WORK FOR THE COUNTY AND 25% WORK FOR THE WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM.

MRS. FAYE BAILEY QUESTIONED THE BOARD AS TO WHY THE BOARD WOULD LAY HER OFF AND PAY UNEMPLOYMENT ON HER A \$175.00 PER WEEK INSTEAD OF KEEPING HER ON AND ENABLEING HER TO WORK FOR THE COUNTY AT \$200.00 PER WEEK.

COMMISSIONER WOOD STATED ON THE 1ST OF SEPTEMBER HE WAS IN AGREEMENT TO HER WORKING FOR TWO MORE WEEKS AT A REDUCED RATE OF PAY EVEN THOUGH NO WEATHERIZATION CONTRACT HAD COME IN. THE BOARD AT THIS TIME TABLED THE ISSUE UNTIL THURSDAY NIGHT SEPTEMBER 17, 1987.

COMMISSIONER WOOD TOLD MRS. BAILEY "COME ON BACK TO WORK TOMORROW AND THEN BE BACK THURSDAY NIGHT."

THE BOARD RECESSED UNTIL 6:30 P.M. THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 1987 TO CONTINUE WORK ON FISCAL YEAR 86-87 BUDGET REVIEW.
