THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY NATHAN GOODMAN AND FOLLOWED WITH PRAYER BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE TO

COMMISSIONER WOOD PRESENTED A LETTER FROM THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RECOGNIZING RED

OAK VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF CALHOUN COUNTY AND EXPRESSING THE BOARDS GRATITUDE TO THE

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS OF THAT DEPARTMENT.

LETTER PRESENTED RECOGNIZING RED OAK VOL. FIRE DEPARTMENT

ATTY. HOUSE STATED THAT ELLIS MELVIN HAD SPOKEN INRE DRAINAGE DITCH ON HIS PROPERTY

COMM. WOOD TO MEET WITH MR. MELVIN

ARBITRATION ON RD DEPARTMENT DISCUSSED

LETTER FROM D.O.T INRE COUNTY ROAD 73

ATTY. HOUSE REPORTED ON TITLE SEARCH ON GASKIN PROPERTY, CLERK WISE STATED NCNB & C&L WOULD LETTER ALSO STATED THE RED OAK FIRE DEPARTMENT WAS DESIROUS OF OBTAINING A FIRE TRUCK FROM THE FLORIDA FOREST SERVICE. ATTORNEY HOUSE STATED THAT ELLIS MELVIN HAD SPOKEN WITH HIM. RE: A COUNTY DRAINAGE WHICH MR. MELVIN BELIEVES TO BE ON HIS PROPERTY AND

COVER UP. AFTER DISCUSSION, COMMISSIONER WOOD STATED HE

WOULD MEET WITH MR. MELVIN ON THE DITCH.

WHICH MR. MELVIN WOULD LIKE TO COUNTY TO

ATTORNEY HOUSE STATED HE HAS WRITTEN TO JUDGE HIGBY AND ATTORNEY CURLEE DOLTIE, RE: ARBITRATION ON THE ROAD DEPARTMENT DISPUTE AND WAS TRYING TO OBTAIN A MUTUAL HEARING DATE FOR ALL PARTIES INVOLVED.

ATTORNEY HOUSE PRESENTED A LETTER FROM W. E. WADDELL, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, RE: RECLASSIFYING COUNTY ROAD 73 IN JACKSON AND CALHOUN COUNTIES TO A STATE ROAD.

ATTORNEY HOUSE REPORTED HE HAD DONE A TITLE SEARCH ON THE TOT GASKIN PROPERTY. CLERK WISE, STATED NCNB AND C&L HAD INDICATED THEY WOULD LOAN THE MONEY TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY

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LOAN THE BOARD THE MONEY

COMMISSIONERS AND THE INTEREST RATE WOULD BE 1% OVER PRIME. THE BOARD'S COUNTY ATTORNEY AND CLERK DISCUSSED THE \$8,000,000.00 INDUSTRIAL BOND ISSUE FOR SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD.

AFTER DISCUSSION, MOTION SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD BY COMMISSIONER INDUSTRIAL BOND DISCUSSED RICHARD'S, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND DULY CARRIED TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD, INC. IN THE PURSUIT OF INDUSTRIAL REVENUE BONDS TO FINANCE THE COST OF A FACILITY FOR THE RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT OF MANUFACTURING OF FIBERBOARD AS AS THE INSTALLATION OF AN WELL ENERGY PRODUCING SYSTEM FOR SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD, INC.

FREEMAN VS CALHOUN COUNTY ATTORNEY HOUSE REPORTED THE LAW SUIT KERMIT REPORT FREEMAN -VS- CALHOUN COUNTY ET AL, HAS BEEN DISMISSED.

DANNY CARPENTER, GRQ SERVICES PRESENT TO DISCUSS WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

ROAD STRIPPING BIDS PRESENTED DANNY CARPENTER, REPRESENTING GRQ SERVICES, INC. OF TALLAHASSEE WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO DISCUSS WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR CALHOUN COUNTY AND TO OFFER THEIR SERVICES TO THE BOARD, RE: VOLUNTARY OR MANDATORY HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE PICK UP.

COMMISSION PRESENTED BIDS RECEIVED ON ROAD STRIPPING, AS FOLLOWS:

AFTER DISCUSSION AND REVIEW OF THE BIDS, MOTION BY COMMISSIONER RICHARDS TO ACCEPT THE BID FROM PEEK PAVEMENT MARKING PURSUANT TO THE ROAD SUPT. CHECKING TO SEE IF PAINT MEETS DOT SPECKS. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND CARRIED 5 TO O.

MIKE SULLIVAN, PASTOR OF MAGNOLIA BAPTIST CHURCH AND DELEGATION WERE PRESENT AT THE BOARD MEETING TO DISCUSS THEIR STANDING ON THE PAVING ON THE MAGNOLIA CHURCH ROAD.

COMMISSIONER WOOD STATED AS HE HAD STATED BEFORE, WHEN FUNDS BECOME AVAILABLE FOR NEW PAVING MAGNOLIA BAPTIST CHURCH WOULD BE THE FIRST PRIORITY FOR DISTRICT 3. UNTIL THE TIME THAT FUNDS BECAME AVAILABLE HE STATED THE COUNTY WOULD MAINTAIN THE ROAD.

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COMMISSIONER DILLARD PRESENTED HOUSES/MOBILE HOMES TO BE ADVERTISED FOR BID FOR CONTRACTING SERVICES IN THE WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM.

MOTION BY COMMISSIONER DILLARD TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS ON 7 HOUSES AND MOBILE HOMES TO BE WEATHERIZED IN THE WEATHERIZATION PROGRAM. MOTION SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND CARRIED 5-0.

THE BOARD DISCUSSED WATER SAMPLING AT THE LANDFILL. AFTER DISCUSSION THE BOARD WAS POLLED RE: PAYING PIONEER LABORATORIES AN ADDITIONAL \$120.00 FOR WATER SAMPLING. COMMISSIONER WOOD, YES, COMMISSIONER HIRES, YES, COMMISSIONER RICHARDS, YES, COMMISSIONER GRANT, YES, AND COMMISSIONER DILLARD, NO.

THE BOARD AGREED BY CONSENSUS TO PAY GENE BAILEY THE MONEY OWED HIM ON CDBG WORK FROM THE GENERAL FUND TEMPORARILY UNTIL IT IS REPLACED. WHEN DCA FUNDS COME IN FOR THAT PROGRAM. MR. BAILEY'S WORK HAS BEEN COMPLETED, BUT DUE TO THE HOLIDAYS THAT BOARD HAS NOT RECOVERED THE FUNDS FROM DCA.

MR. BAILEY WAS PRESENT AND AGREED TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO FACILIATE THIS TRANSACTION AS IT WAS FOR HIS BENEFIT.

THE BOARD DISCUSSED GEORGE KEARCE'S HOURS AND AND AFTER DISCUSSION LEFT THE DECISION WITH ALVIN ROBERTS HIS SUPERVISOR AS TO WHAT HOURS HE WANTED MR. KEARCE TO WORK.

COMMISSIONER WOOD RELATED INCIDENTS OF OUT OF COUNTY CITIZENS DUMPING GARBAGE AT THE CALHOUN COUNTY LANDFILL. COMMISSIONER WOOD RECOMMENDED THE BOARD ADVERTISE IN THE PAPER THAT THE LANDFILL GATES WILL BE LOCKED AT A CERTAIN HOUR AND ALSO TO POST AN EMPLOYEE IN THE HOUSE AT THE LANDFILL UNTIL 9:00 OR 10:00 P.M. TO ENABLE THEM TO NOTIFY THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT WHEN NECESSARY IN ORDER TO PREVENT SUCH DUMPING FROM HAPPENING.

AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION, A MOTION BY COMMISSIONER DILLARD TO PLACE A GATE AT THE ENTRANCE OF THE SANITARY LANDFILL OFF THE COUNTY ROAD AND PUBLISH IN THE COUNTY RECORD, THAT THE GATE WILL BE OPEN FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M., SEVEN DAYS A WEEK PURSUANT TO DER REGULATIONS. SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND CARRIED 5-0.

COMMISSIONER WOOD REPORTED ON THE FIVE COUNTY FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR SOLID WASTE AND PRESENTED A LETTER FROM THE GOVERNORS ENERGY OFFICE ANNOUNCING A NEW PROGRAM FOR LOCAL AND

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WEATHERIZATION HOUSES/ MOBILE HOMES PRESENTED FOR BIDS

MOTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS ON 7 HOUSES FOR WEATHERIZATION

BOARD AGREES TO PAY PIONEER LAB. FOR WATER SAMPLING

MONEY TO BE PAID TO GENE BAILEY OUT OF GENERAL FUND UNTIL CDBG FUNDS COME IN

MR. BAILEY AGREED TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY FOR THIS TRANSACTION

GEORGE KEARCE'S HOURS DISCUSSED

COUNTY LANDFILL HOURS DISCUSSED

MOTION TO PLACE A GATE AT THE LANDFILL AND POST HOURS OF OPERATION

LETTER PRESENTED ON FIVE COUNTY FEASIBILITY STUDY

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REGIONAL GOVERNMENTS FOR STUDY ON SOLID WASTE.

THE BOARD AGREED BY CONSENSUS TO STAY IN THE FIVE COUNTY FIESIBILITY STUDY AND TO APPLY FOR THE NEW PROGRAM AVAILABLE FROM THE GOVERNORS ENERGY OFFICE.

COMMISSIONER WOOD PRESENTED REQUEST FROM JERRY AUSLEY, FARMERS HOME ADMINISTRATION ASKING FOR ADDITIONAL WORK SPACE ON THE THIRD FLOOR, THEREBY INCREASING IT'S SPACE TO 2,360. MR. AUSLEY STATED THIS COULD BE ACCOMPLISHED BY ADDING THE VACANT ROOM THAT ADJOINS FMHA OFFICE ON THE NORTH. HE STATED THEY WOULD NEED ONE WALL EXTENDED AND TWO DOORS CUT. THE BOARD TABLED THE RENTAL SPACE ISSUE UNTIL COMMISSIONER WOOD COULD DO FURTHER RESEARCH.

COMMISSIONER WOOD PRESENTED AND DISCUSSED A LETTER FROM FRED PIERCE, RE: AMBULANCE SERVICE AND BILLS RESULTING FROM SAME.

COMMISSIONER WOOD PRESENTED LETTER FROM DICK WELHELM, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE THANKING SHIRLEY STONE, COUNTY EXTENSION OFFICE FOR HER WORK AND ASSISTANCE TO MR. WILHELM WHILE WORKING ON NORTHWEST FLORIDA AGRICULTURE DEMONSTRATION.

COMMISSIONER WOOD PRESENTED A LETTER FROM UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION BI-CENTENNIAL COMMISSION OF FLORIDA. THE BOARD AGREED TO SUPPORT THE SCHOOL SYSTEM IN EFFORTS TO BECOME A BI-CENTENIAL COMMUNITY.

THE MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 03, 1987 WERE READ AND APPROVED AS READ.

COMMISSIONER RICHARDS MOVED TO SEND A MEMO TO ALL DEPARTMENT HEADS, ESTABLISHING A NEW POLICY FOR SICK AND ANNUAL LEAVE AS PER COMMISSIONER HIRES MOTION ON 11-3-87 TO PRORATE ANNUAL AND SICK LEAVE AT ONE DAY MONTH AS APPROVED BY AUDITOR T. MICHAEL TUCKER. SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HIRES AND DULY CARRIED.

MOTION TO ADJOURN BY COMMISSIONER DILLARD, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER RICHARDS AND DULY CARRIED.
