CALL TO ORDER TO DIS-CUSS E.D.A. GRANT APP. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY COMMISSIONER WOOD FOR THE PURPOSE OF A DISCUSSION ON E.D.A. GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE AGRICULTURE PARK.

LOGAN BARBEE RELATES TO THE BOARD THAT THE GRANT APPL. HAD BEEN APPROVED AT 60%, THUS REQUIRING MORE CASH FROM THE COUNTY

LOGAN BARBEE, COUNTY EXTENSION AGENT RELATED TO THE BOARD THAT HE HAD RECEIVED A CALL FROM MARSHA HARPOOL, APALACHEE REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL STATING THE E.D.A. GRANT PRE-APPLICATION HAD BEEN APPROVED, HOWEVER, IT HAD BEEN APPROVED AT 60% INSTEAD OF THE 80% THAT THE BOARD HAD ANTICIPATED AND THAT \$105,000.00 MORE WAS NEEDED MAKING A TOTAL OF \$342,000.00 CASH TO BE PROVIDED BY THE BOARD. HE SAID THE BOARD NEEDED TO DECIDE TONIGHT IF THEY COULD PROVIDE THE ADDITIONAL MONEY SO THAT MRS. MARGARET MCINTOSH, WITH E.D.A. COULD BE NOTIFIED AS WHETHER TO PROCEED OR NOT.

MS. HARPOOL STATED
THAT THE CLOSING OF
SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD
MIGHT HAVE AN IMPACT ON
THE GRANT PERCENTAGE

MARSHA HARPOOL, APALACHEE REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL STATED SINCE THE CLOSING OF SOUTHEASTERN FIBERBOARD THE GRANT MIGHT BE RE CONSTRUCTED TO SHOW TO SHOW SEVERE ECONOMIC HARDSHIP AND POSSIBLE OBTAIN FULL FUNDING FROM E.D.A. FOR THE AG. PARK.

AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION, MS. HARPOOL RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD WRITE A LETTER OF INTENT TO E.D.A. STATING THAT THE BOARD WOULD PROVIDE THE ADDITIONAL MONEY AND AT THE SAME TIME PURSUE THE ECONOMIC HARDSHIP GRANT FOR POSSIBLE FUNDING.

BOBBY O'BRYAN RECOMMENDS BOARD TAKE ALL STEPS NEC-ESSARY TO INSURE THE GRANT BOBBY O'BRYAN, CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD TAKE WHATEVER STEPS NECESSARY AND EXPLORE ALL AVENUES TO INSURE THAT THE AGRI. PARK WILL BENEFIT AND BOOST ALL CITIZENS OF CALHOUN COUNTY ECONOMICALLY.
