The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Wood for the purpose of tentatively adopting a budget for Fiscal-Year 88-89.

After review of proposed budget, Motion was made by Commissioner Dillard, seconded by Commissioner Grant and carried 5-0 to tentatively adopt the budget with a millage rate of 10 mills.

Commissioner Wood reported County Judge, Phillip Knight had requested that a typewriter be purchased for the Probation Department since funds were still available in the probation 87-88 probation budget and the typewriter was needed. (See attached quotes)

After discussion, the Board by Consensus tabled the purchase of the typewriter for the probation department until further work can be done on the budget in order to see if funds are available.

There being no further business, Motion was made by Commissioner Hires, seconded by Commissioner Dillard and carried 5-0 to adjourn.
