



BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MINUTES OF MEETING JULY 14, 1989

The Board of County Commissioners met this date in special session.

COMMISSIONERS PRESENT:

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Whitfield, followed with prayer by Commissioner Cox, and pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Commissioner Whitfield stated the purpose of the meeting was for review of the 1988-1989 budget and audit and proposed budget 1989-90 workshop on borrow pits in order to adhere to state requirements. He stated the bond issue for Calhoun Fibreboard was scheduled for discussion however, the county attorney had court hearings and could not be present and the Calhoun Fibreboard bond issue would not be discussed unless the county attorney finished his hearings early and could be present at the meeting.

Clerk Wise presented the board with a proposed budget for 1989-90, based upon budget request received with a millage rate of 14.55.

The board and clerk reviewed anticipated revenues and proposed expenditures for FY 1989-90.

Clerk Wise stated \$578,000.00 needed to be cut from the proposed budget in order to bring the millage rate to 10 mills.

The board decided to have budget hearings and asked that elected officials be present for budget justifications.

The board discussed budget and budget justification with elected official that were present at the board meeting.

After much deliberation and review, the board cut from the general fund \$77,519.00 and from fine and forfeiture \$111,977.00.

The board tabled budget workshop until a later date.

Clerk Wise presented, and the board discussed information received from the state on requirements for borrow pits, relating to reclaimation requirements of pits, after pits use is over. Commissioner Cox, and Commissioner Melvin to read and research.

There being no further business, the board did then adjourn.
