ATTORNEY CORBIN REPORTED THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RELATIONS COMMISSION
HAD APPOINTED ANNE H. AVERA AS HEARING OFFICER IN AN ORDER DATED
09/25/90 AND THAT SHE HAD TENTATIVELY SCHEDULED AN EVIDENTIARY
HEARING FOR OCTOBER 29, 1990. HE SAID THE HEARING WOULD NOT HAVE TO BE
HELD IF THE BOARD AGREED WITH THE UNIT AS LAID OUT IN THE PETITION.
HE RELAYED OCTOBER 10TH IS THE DEADLINE FOR FILING A RESPONSE WITH
PERK FOR AGREEING OR NOT WITH THE UNIT PROPOSED BY PETITIONER.
ATTORNEY CORBIN SAID THE COUNTY MUST FILE AN ALPHABETIZED LIST OF
EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION AND JOB DESCRIPTIONS. HE ADVISED THE BOARD
THAT THEY NEED TO REVIEW THE PROPOSED UNIT AND DETERMINE IF ANY
EMPLOYEES SHOULD NOT BE INCLUDED OR IF THERE ARE ANY EMPLOYEES THAT
ARE NOT INCLUDED THAT SHOULD BE INCLUDED. ATTORNEY CORBIN SAID IF THE
BOARD AGREES WITH THE PROPOSED UNIT, THEY COULD GO AHEAD AND GIVE
CONSENT FOR ELECTION.

AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION, THE BOARD, BASED ON RECOMMENDATION OF COUNTY
ATTORNEY, AGREED BY CONSENSUS ON THE UNIT AS PROPOSED IN THE
PETITION AND ALSO AGREED TO FURNISH AN ALPHABETIZED LIST OF
CLASSIFICATIONS AND JOB DESCRIPTION OF EMPLOYEES AND TO ENTER INTO
A CONSENT FOR ELECTION WITH OUT AN EVIDENTIARY HEARING.

THE BOARD REVIEWED AND DISCUSSED THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AS
PRESENTED BY MR. CORBIN FOR COUNTY ATTORNEY SERVICES.

AFTER DISCUSSION, MOTION BY COMMISSIONER MELVIN, 2ND COMMISSIONER
COX, AND DULY CARRIED TO ADOPT MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN BOARD
OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND BILL A. CORBIN.

COMMISSIONER MELVIN APPOINTED CLIFFORD MAYO AS PLANNING COMMISSION
MEMBER FROM DISTRICT 3.

COMMISSIONER MELVIN APPOINTED TIMOTHY MOWERY AS DISTRICT 3'S MEMBER

TO THE IDA BOARD.

THE BOARD DISCUSSED THE BAILEY PIT AND COMMISSIONER MELVIN REQUESTED THAT A SURVEYOR SURVEY THE BAILEY PIT IN ORDER TO DETERMINE LINES OF EXISTING PIT. THE BOARD AGREED TO CONTACT ROBERT NATIONS REGARDING SURVEYING THE BAILEY PIT.

COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD REPORTED DOWLING PARRISH, BUILDING INSPECTOR, HAD REQUESTED USE OF A COUNTY TRUCK TO GO TO AVON PARK TO PICK UP DONATED BUNKER EQUIPMENT FOR THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT. THE BOARD AGREED BY CONSENSUS.

THE BOARD APPROVED THE MINUTES OF AUGUST 7, SEPT. 5, SEPT. 6, SEPT. 14, SEPT, 17, SEPT. 18, SEPT. 19, SEPT. 25, AND SEPT. 27, 1990.
