MS. MARSHA HARPOOL OF THE APALACHEE REGIONAL PLANNING COUNCIL (ARPC) EXPLAINED THE PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING AND EXPLAINED THE EXTENSION UNTIL DECEMBER 12, 1992 IS THE FINAL EXTENSION TO BE GRANTED ON THE CREATION OF THE JOBS.

MR. FRANK GATES OF FLORIDA AQUACULTURE PROCESSOR COOPERATIVE (FAPC) REPORTED THAT IT WOULD BE 60-90 DAYS UNTIL FAPC COULD BE UP AND RUNNING WITH THE FHA LOAN FUNDS. MR. GATES EXPLAINED THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE LOAN AND STATED THAT FAPC MEMBERS WERE WORKING TO MEET EACH REQUIREMENT.


