EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR SONNY O'BRYAN GAVE THE BOARD AN UPDATE ON THE CURRENT RIVER READINGS AND THE WEATHER CONDITIONS.

FOLLOWING LENGTHY DISCUSSION THE MOTION WAS MADÉ BY COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BOWDEN TO ADOPT A PROPOSED EMERGENCY EVACUATION RESOLUTION. MOTION CARRIED 4-0.

DISCUSSION WAS HELD WITH THE CHIEF OF POLICE, SHERIFF AND COUNTY BCC AND IT WAS AGREED THAT THE EMERGENCY RESOLUTION WILL BE EFFECTIVE BASED UPON RIVER READINGS AT DESIGNATED LOCATIONS BEGINNING AT 23.5° AT APALACHICOLA RIVER. THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS AND RIVER LEVELS WERE DETERMINED:

PARRISH LAKE ROAD - 23°
MASON ROAD - 24.5°
OVERHOLT'S - 24.5°
DENNIS PARRISH ROAD - 23°
MAYHAW COMMUNITY - 24.5°
RIVER STREET - 24.5°
JOHN REDD ROAD - 25°
GRAVES CREEK - 25°
HWY 20 EAST - 25.5°
JANET STREET - 23°
HUGH CREEK - 24.5°

COOPERS ROAD - 24.5° MCDANIELS ROAD - 24.5° FITTEN ROAD - 24.5°

MANDATORY EVACUATION WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CALHOUN COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR, CALHOUN COUNTY SHERIFF, AND THE BLOUNTSTOWN CHIEF OF POLICE.
