

CHAIRMAN ATTAWAY CALLED THE SPECIAL MEETING TO ORDER. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING WITH MR. CRAIG MCMILLAN OF PAT THOMAS & ASSOCIATES AND REPRESENTATIVES FROM GOVERNMENTAL RISK INSURANCE TRUST WAS TO DISCUSS AND DETERMINE THE FACTORS NEEDED TO BE RECOGNIZED REGARDING WORKER'S COMPENSATION.

FOLLOWING DISCUSSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE COUNTY'S WORKER'S COMPENSATION REPRESENTATIVES IT WAS DETERMINED THAT WITHIN 60 DAYS THE COUNTY WOULD PROVIDE A CENTRAL CONTROL PERSON THAT WOULD SCREEN ALL NEW EMPLOYEES AND FILE ALL WORKER'S COMPENSATION CLAIMS. THE COUNTY WOULD ALSO HAVE UNIFORM HIRING AND DRUG SCREENING POLICIES AND WILL ADOPT A LIGHT DUTY POLICY.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE BOARD DID ADJOURN.
