CALHOUN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS PUBLIC HEARING MAY 15, 1996 6:00

CHAIRMAN ATTAWAY CALLED THE PUBLIC HEARING TO ORDER.

COUNTY ATTORNEY MATT FUQUA READ ORDINANCE 96-02 AMENDING THE CALHOUN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF A CERTAIN SMALL-SCALE FUTURE LAND USE MAP AMENDMENT TO THE CALHOUN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FOR REPLEALER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

MR. BILL NORRIS STATED THE FACILITY HE PROPOSES TO BUILD WILL NOT BE USED AS A SLAUGHTERING FACILITY. THE FACILITY WILL PACKAGE MEAT THAT HAS BEEN STAMPED AND PARTIAL CARCASSES. HE FURTHER STATED THAT NO ANIMALS WILL BE SLAUGHTERED ON THE PREMISES.

COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD REQUESTED THAT MR. NORRIS REVISIT HIS NEIGHBORS PRIOR TO THE NEXT PUBLIC HEARING ON MAY 21, TO ASSURE THEM THAT HIS FACILITY WILL NOT BE A SLAUGHTERING FACILITY.

COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD FURTHER STATED THAT HE HAS NO PROBLEM WITH MR. NORRIS' FACILITY AS LONG AS IT REMAINS A MEAT PACKAGING FACILITY BUT WILL HAVE A PROBLEM IF IT BECOMES A SLAUGHTER HOUSE.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE PUBLIC HEARING ADJOURNED.
