

CALHOUN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING
AUGUST 6, 1996

DEPUTY VICKERY CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER. CHAIRMAN ATTAWAY LED IN PRAYER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

SPUD DAVIS ADDED TO THE AGENDA.

BIDS WERE RECEIVED, OPENED AND READ ALOUD ON THE VOTING PRECINCT BUILDINGS. THE BIDS WERE AS FOLLOWS:

MOTION MADE BY COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD TO ACCEPT HIGH BID PER BIDDER, PER VOTING HOUSE, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER BOWDEN. MOTION CARRIED 5-0.

MR. SONNY O'BRYAN REPORTED TO THE BCC REGARDING THE LAND SURVEY AT CLAY MARY PARK. AS PER THE SURVEY DONE BY SNOWDEN LAND SURVEYING, THE BOUNDARIES AS DEEDED TO THE COUNTY BY THE SCHOOL BOARD SHOW THE COUNTY'S PROPERTY OVERLAPS THE ADJACENT LAND OWNERS.

THE COUNTY AGREES TO SIGN A QUIT CLAIM DEED TOT HE ADJACENT LAND OWNERS IS REQUESTED TO DO SO.

MR. O'BRYAN REQUESTED AUTHORIZATION BY THE BCC TO ALLOW HIM TO MEET WITH CALHOUN-LIBERTY ABSTRACT TO WORK OUT THE BOUNDARIES.

MOTION MADE BY COMMISSIONER GRANT TO AUTHORIZE MR. O'BRYAN TO MEET WITH CALHOUN-LIBERTY ABSTRACT TO WORK OUT THE BOUNDARIES. MOTION SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD AND CARRIED 5-0.

MR. O'BRYAN PRESENTED THE BCC A LETTER FROM WATER SPIGOT INFORMING THE BOARD THAT THE PARAMETERS OF TESTING ON THE LANDFILL HAVE CHANGES. WITH THESE CHANGES, THE COSTS OF THE TESTS HAVE CONSIDERABLY INCREASED.

MOTION MADE BY COMMISSIONER WHITFIELD TO ADVERTISE THE WATER ANALYSIS AND SAMPLING OF THE LANDFILL DUE TO THE INCREASE OF COSTS AS STATED BY THE WATER SPIGOT. COMMISSIONER CAPPS SECONDED. MOTION CARRIED 5-0.

MR. O'BRYAN DISCUSSED WITH THE BOARD THE NEED THE RECYCLING PROGRAM HAS FOR A TANDEM HYDRAULIC DUMP TRAILER. THIS WILL ENABLE THE EMPLOYEES TO SPEED UP THE PROCESS OF HANDLING THE RECYCLABLE.

THE BCC CONCURRED WITH AUTHORIZING MR. O'BRYAN TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS ON TWO TANDEM HYDRAULIC DUMP TRAILERS WITH 4 BINS FOR THE RECYCLING CENTER.

MR. ROBERT COONER, ROAD SUPERINTENDENT ADDRESSED THE BOARD TO REPORT ON THE BRIDGES INSPECTED BY THE STATE. FIVE BRIDGES ARE IN NEED OF RIP RAP TO REPAIR AND DETER EROSION.

MR. COONER GAVE THE BCC AN ESTIMATE ON POSTS AND WIRE REQUIRED TO CLOSE THE BAILEY PIT ON SHUMAN FERRY ROAD.

MR. DOWLING PARRISH CAME BEFORE THE BCC TO ASK IF A DECISION HAD BEEN MADE REGARDING HIS PAY INCREASE AS REPORTED IN THE MINUTES OF AA/24/92 SPECIAL MEETING.

COMMISSIONER BOWDEN STATED HE HAD RESEARCHED THE MINUTES PRIOR AND FOLLOWING THE 11/24/92 SPECIAL MEETING AND HE FOUND NO FORMAL MOTION OR ACTION OF THE BCC REGARDING THE PAY INCREASE.

COUNTY ATTORNEY FUQUA STATED HIS OPINION IS THAT NO PAY INCREASE VOUCHER HAD BEEN SIGNED GRANTING THIS PAY INCREASE.

CHAIRMAN ATTAWAY STATED HE RECALLED THE BOARD AGREEING TO GIVE MR. PARRISH AN INCREASE OF \$100 PER MONTH.

SPUD DAVIS ADDRESSED THE BOARD REGARDING THE PARKING AROUND THE COURTHOUSE.

THE BCC INSTRUCTED COUNTY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE VISITOR PARKING AT THE COURTHOUSE WITH A 2 HOUR LIMIT.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE BOARD DID ADJOURN.
