Mr. O'Bryan discussed with the Board the Calhoun County Community Traffic Safety Team's (CTST) application to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for County Road 274 West widening project. He stated that the Florida Department of Transportation has approved the application and is currently being processed.

Mr. O'Bryan discussed with the Board the closeout of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

Mr. O'Bryan presented to the Board a Change Order from Glenn T. Warren & Company on Porter Grade Road for an additional 40' of pipe and mitered ends. After discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Whitfield, seconded by Commissioner Hunt and carried to approve said change order for an increase of \$1,770.00.

Mr. O'Bryan presented to the Board a change order from I-C Contractors, Inc. on Capt. Lynn and River Road for an increase of \$5,964.53. After discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Pickron, seconded by Commissioner Hunt and carried to approve said change order for an increase of \$5,964.53.

Commissioner Pickron discussed with the Board the possibility of Dowling Parrish, Building Inspector inspecting the City of Blountstown's new additions and building. **COMMISSIONER HUNT**

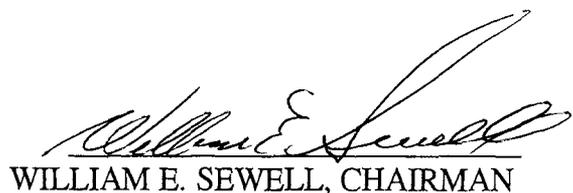
Commissioner Hunt discussed with the Board the slow response from the telephone company when installing culverts.
