## CALHOUN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL BOARD MEETING NOVEMBER 29, 2012

The meeting was called to order by Deputy McKee. Prayer and pledge of allegiance to the flag was led by Commissioner McDougald.

The Board discussed the elimination of the County Administrator position. Commissioner McDougald stated that Mr. O'Bryan held certifications in Emergency Management and the Local Area Program (LAP). Commissioner McDougald made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Grant for Mr. O'Bryan to remain as Public Works Director, and Emergency management Director with his salary remaining the same. Motion fails with a 3 to 2 vote.

Mr. O'Bryan discussed positions under the Board and praised County employees for jobs well done.

Several citizens in the audience came forth and praised Mr. O'Bryan for his job performance.

Commissioner McDougald made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Grant and carried to cut Mr. O'Bryan's hours back to 31 hours per week and to cut his pay to \$50,000.00 annually with full benefits. Commissioners Brown and Flowers voted no.

Chairman Flowers discussed with Mr. O'Bryan and the Board the Assistance Administrator position. This discussion will be brought up at the December 4, 2012 Board Meeting.

Chairman Flowers stated that the Road Department is in need of a transmission for one of the county vehicles. He said that the transmission would cost approximately \$5,312.50 and asked the Board to approve the sole source purchase. After discussion a motion was made by Commissioner McDougald, seconded by Commissioner Grant and carried to approve the above request.

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
