ABANDONMENT OF RIVERSIDE PLAT

Mr. Snowden advised the Board St. Joe Land and Development Co. has requested to vacate the subdivision for Riverside on the Chipola River. (There was not a representative from St Joe Land and Development Co. at this meeting.) Commissioner Flowers stated St Joe Land and Development Co. is asking for this to reduce their ad valorem taxes. There was further discussion of whether the land can be changed back to timber land since there are now paved roads. (Mr. Wood advised the Board St. Joe Land and Development Co. owns the Chipola Park on Highway 20.) The Board agreed by consensus to further discuss this matter during the Planning Commission meeting on March 8, 2016.

OTHER MATTERS


