

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-05

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CALHOUN COUNTY, FLORIDA, ENCOURAGING UTILITIES TO BE PLACED IN THE COUNTY ROAD RIGHT OF WAYS, PROVIDING FOR PERMITTING, PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CALHOUN, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1: Whereas, utility companies, from time to time, need to expand, construct, or maintain services and it is most efficient for the services to be placed in the right of ways owned by Calhoun County, and such placement in the road right of ways is desired by the County. This ordinance is being enacted to avoid future confusion as to the responsibility for the cost of relocating utilities as provided by Florida Law, pursuant to Florida Statute 337.403, which is incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: Any utility company desiring to place a utility on property owned by Calhoun County, including but not limited to, road right of ways, shall obtain a permit from the Calhoun County Road Department. The utility company, in applying for the permit, shall detail the type of utility service to be placed in the right of way and provide construction plans if they are available. The Calhoun County Road Department shall issue a permit, at no charge, to the subject Utility company.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective upon being enacted and filed with the Secretary of State.
