CALHOUN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2003 - 02

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISPOSAL OF AN ANIMAL CARCASS ALONGSIDE A PUBLIC ROAD, PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY, OR PUBLIC PROPERTY; PROVIDING PENALTIES AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there are many acres of land within Calhoun County that are hunted during hunting season; and

WHEREAS, several complaints have been received that during hunting season animal carcasses are left alongside public roads, public rights of way or on public property;

WHEREAS, the animal carcasses that are left alongside public roads, public rights of way, or on public property are visually disturbing to the public and also create unsanitary conditions; and

WHEREAS, no person has any legal authority or right to dump an animal carcass alongside a public road, public right of way or on public property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CALHOUN COUNTY, FLORIDA:

- 1. It is unlawful for any person to dispose of an animal carcass alongside a public road, public right of way or on public property.
- Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in Florida Statute §775.082 or Florida Statute §775.083.
- 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners in and for Calhoun County, after due notice and publication, in the regular meeting on the 18th day of March, 2003, and upon being filed with the Secretary of State.
