

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025- 01**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION  
CALHOUN COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING  
CALHOUN COUNTY ORDINANCE 2002-05 RELATING  
TO PERMITS FOR UTILITIES, PROVIDING FOR  
CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas the Board of County Commissioners for Calhoun County, Florida has determined that Ordinance 2002-05 should be amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF CALHOUN COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

**SECTION 1 of ordinance 2002-5** is hereby amended (~~strike~~throughs are deletions and underlines are additions) as follows;

*Any utility company desiring to place a utility on property owned by Calhoun County, including but not limited to, road right of ways, shall obtain a permit from the ~~Calhoun County Road Department~~ Calhoun County Planning Department. The utility company, in applying for the permit, shall detail the type of utility service to be placed in the right of way and provide construction plans if they are available. The ~~Calhoun County Road Department~~ Calhoun County Planning Department shall issue a permit, at no charge to the subject Utility company.*

**SECTION II. CONFLICTS.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION III. SEVERABILITY.**

If any word, phrase, clause, section or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion or words shall be deemed a separate and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage as provided by law.
